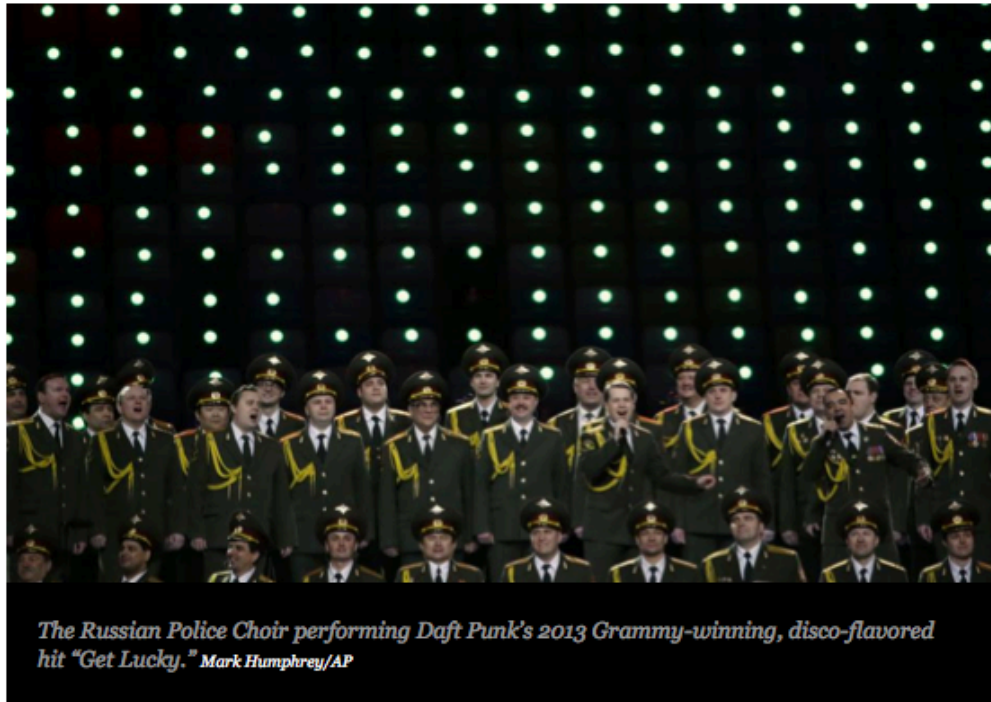


Russian Police Choir's Amazing Daft Punk Cover

On the opening night of NBC's Winter Olympics coverage from Sochi, host Bob Costas engaged in a serious discussion about homosexuality in Russia with David Remnick, managing editor of *The New Yorker*, and Russian-American journalist Vladimir Pozner.
