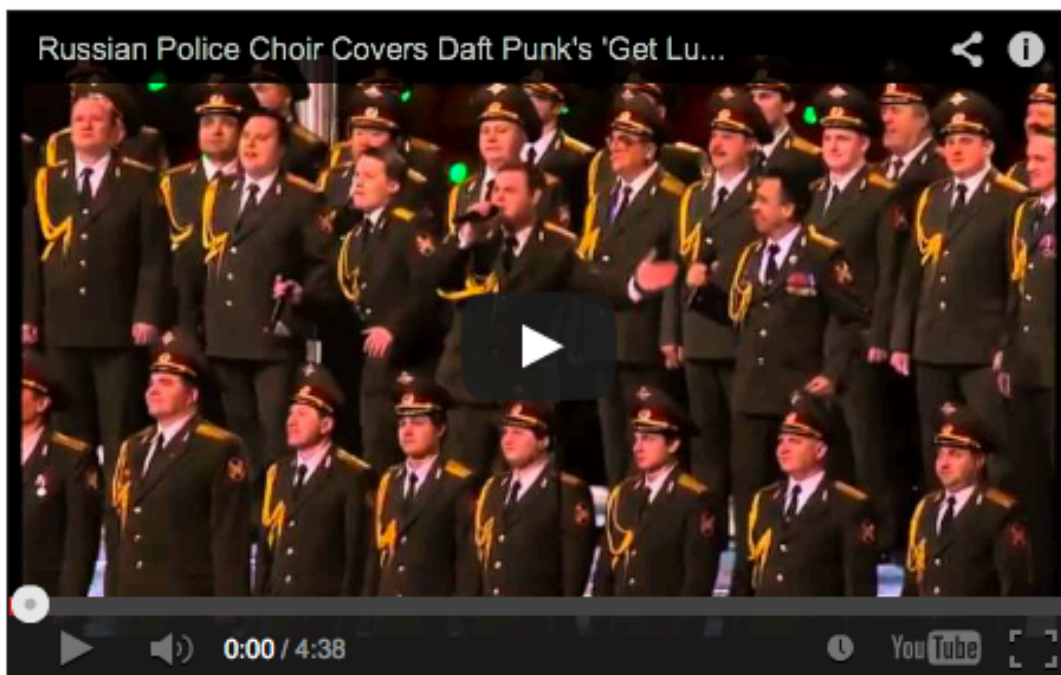


Russian Army Choir Sings Daft Punk's 'Get Lucky' at Sochi Winter Olympics [VIDEO]
